


Requesting REcolorado IDX Data in Trestle


REcolorado is excited to offer our IDX data customers the ability to receive IDX data via Web API, using CoreLogic's Trestle™ platform.

To get started with REcolorado's IDX data via Web API, you'll need to set up an account in Trestle.

1. Go to trestle.corelogic.com.
2. From the top menu, click **Get Started**.



3. Select **Technology Provider** from the Business Type screen.
Note: Even if you are requesting access as a brokerage, you'll need to select Technology Provider.

4. Enter your contact and company information to create your account. Refer to the [Trestle Help documentation](#) for assistance with account setup.
5. Although you will need to provide a credit card to create your account, you will not be billed for REcolorado data through Trestle. Your bill will continue to come directly from REcolorado.
6. Add product information. During this process, you will create your own User ID & Password for each Data Feed Type.

Note: If you are receiving the same data feed type from multiple MLS's, you will use the same User ID & Password for *ALL* MLS connections.

When using a consolidated feed, MLS Data can be filtered by the Originating System Name. REcolorado's Originating System Name is **MLDENVER**.

7. Under the product tab, complete the fields describing your product and the feed type your product supports.

Note: REcolorado is only offering an [IDX Plus feed via Web API](#) (includes On Market data plus several years of Sold data).

8. After your product configuration is complete, request access to REcolorado's data. From the Trestle dashboard:
 - a. Select **Connections**.
 - b. Select **Add Connection**.
 - c. Next to your IDX product, click **Select** and choose REcolorado.

Note: You may need to choose "Metrolist Inc. d/b/a REcolorado"
 - d. Be sure to select the Web API / IDX Plus feed type.
 - e. Preview the contract, then click **Connect**. This contract is the same as your current REcolorado data licensing agreement, just customized to work within Trestle.
9. Your connection request will be submitted to REcolorado for review and approval. Once approved, you'll be able to begin converting your IDX website to use the Web API.
